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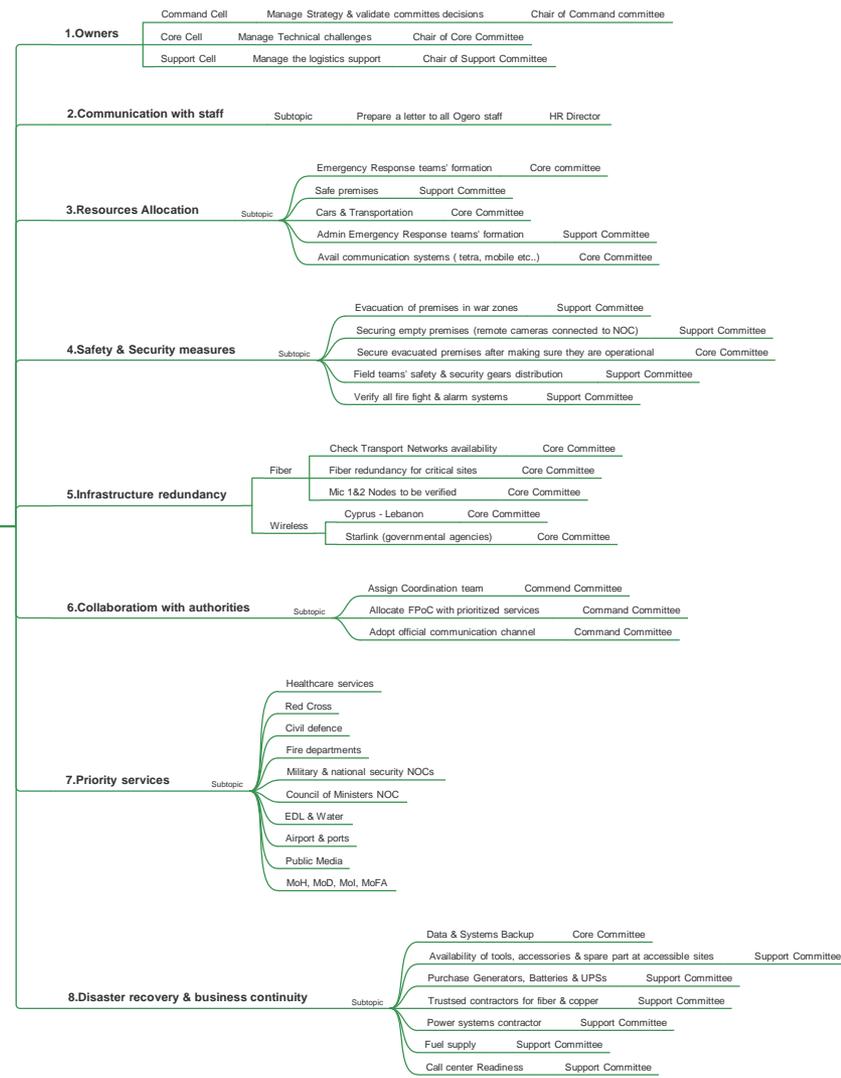
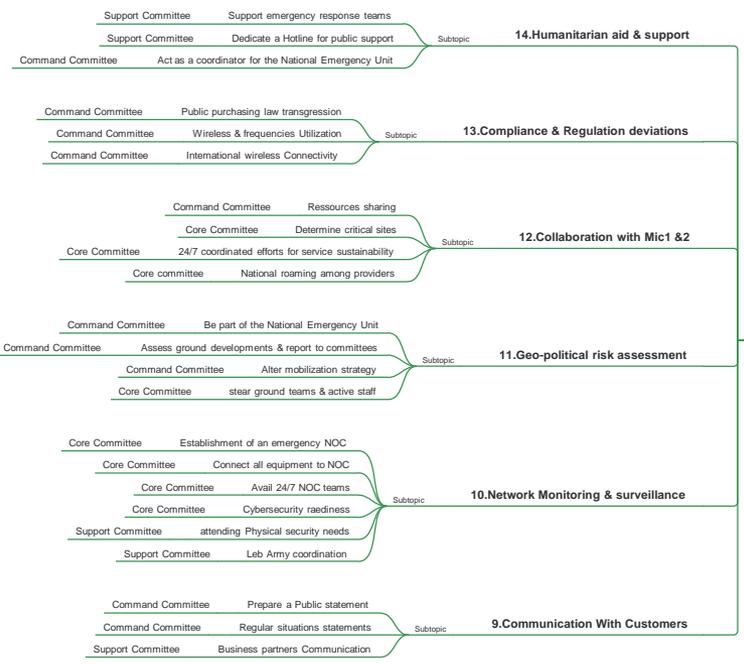
Preamble

In times of a possible military conflict & while Lebanon is facing an unprecedented economic & financial crisis, Ogero telecom may face unique challenges due to the potential disruption of infrastructure, safety and security concerns, and increased demand for communication services. Perfectly aware of the operational limitations Ogero is suffering from, It is our ultimate responsibility to support the Lebanese constituents & their administration face the looming crisis. This document contains a series of action aimed at mitigating war risks from connectivity perspective.

Detailed
actions

1. OT Emergency Champions

1. **Command cell**, shall be responsible for the strategic decisions & the ratifications of the decisions of the Core & Support cells. The members are T. Chebaro, D. Khoury, H. Taki & Imad Kreidieh. **This team is headed by the CDG.**
2. **Core cell**, groups all technical directors who will ensure service sustainability across the nation in the best-case scenario &/or keeping prioritized public services up and running. **This team is headed by Dr. T. Chebaro.**
3. **Support cell**, is responsible for providing logistical support for the core cell in matters of resources allocation, be it HR, material, transportation & communications. The swift actions of this cell is paramount serving the purpose of this plan. **This team is headed by Miss D. Khoury.** The members are H. saad, H. Ibrahim, Pierre Khoury, H. Mosleh, B. Jradi & Ahmad Remlawi

3. Resources allocation

It is essential to prioritize resources such as personnel, equipment, premises & network capacity, to support critical services & areas to be affected by the conflict.

Required Actions:

1. Evacuate “critical” premises & identify safer ones to be utilized by operational teams.
2. Emergency response teams' formation (fiber & Power)
3. Collect all OT cars from nontechnical, non field teams & working from home staff members (except directors), Core Cell chair shall redistribute vehicles on need basis only. Priority is to be given to emergency response teams.
4. Activate Tetra communication systems & devices for internal communication & integrate with other public services using the same
5. Make sure all technical vehicles are usable & properly equipped with tools & parts.
6. Assess bandwidth for emergency allocation

4. Safety & Security

OT most valuable asset remains its staff. The rest is expandable. Consequently, our duty is to always keep our personnel safe. Premises & equipment are to be safeguarded on best efforts basis.

Required Actions:

1. Evacuate “critical” premises & deploy team members to “safer” premises. Work from home is to be planned and encouraged.
2. Secure evacuated premises through the installation & connection of high-definition CCTV systems
3. Make sure equipment are remotely accessible, powered and in good operational status.
4. Activate Tetra communication systems & devices for internal communication & integrate with other public services using the same
5. Field teams to be equipped with security gears, Ogero fluorescent vests, trackable communication devices, etc..
6. Make sure all fire fight systems are operational & ready

5. Infrastructure redundancy

OT, In times of crisis and as part of national security, has the obligation to ensure the country is connected to the rest of the world. It has also the responsibility to keep the country decision making bodies, armed forces, health authorities & emergency response bodies connected.

Required Actions:

1. Urgently assess the availability of all OT transport networks. 100% shall be the required mark.
2. Critical sites identified by Core cell, shall be connected via at least 2 routes.
3. MIC 1&2 nodes must remain connected as long as possible. The use of redundant routes is highly advisable.
4. Wireless connections through friendly countries to be explored immediately using at least 2 sites. (MW links, Vsats)
5. Star link kits to be acquired and distributed to government agencies & emergency response teams.

6. Collaboration with authorities

Ogero Telecom is to urgently establish communication protocols with relevant government authorities, Armed forces, law enforcement agencies, civil defense & fire brigades to ensure exchange of information and guidance with the aim of protecting field teams & sensible premises.

Required Actions

1. Assign a coordination team & a team leader
2. Identify a single focal point of contact in the national emergency unit
3. Adopt official communication channels

7. Priority services

Ogero Telecom aspires to maintain connectivity for all in crisis times. Unfortunately, this option might not be exercisable during armed conflicts. OT shall provide for the most relevant public services while striving to keep a reasonable majority of the constituents connected.

Priority list

1. Prime Minister's office
2. MoH, MoD, Mol, MoFA,
3. Lebanese Army NOC
4. Law enforcement NOC
5. Airport & Ports
6. Hospitals
7. Civil defense
8. Red cross
9. Fire brigades
10. Utility companies (EDL, Water)
11. Public Media

8. Disaster recovery & business continuity

Ogero Telecom shall immediately adopt measures ensuring a robust disaster recovery & business continuity plan to insure swift service restoration for the prioritized services in case of disruption.

Required Actions

1. Timely data & systems backups
2. Tools, essential parts, fiber cables & accessories to be available with field teams &/or at accessible sites
3. New generators in OT critical sites along with the needed batteries & UPSs
4. Engage with trusted & capable CW contractors
5. Engage with trusted fiber cable repair & maintenance contractors
6. Ensure proper fuel supply via a trusted & capable suppliers
7. Train more Customer care agents & immediately avail “work from home” tools & means.

10. Network monitoring & surveillance

It is crucial for OT to maintain visibility on all network elements availability, performance, security & traffic patterns. It is the only way to quickly identify abnormalities & suspicious activities and act upon them.

Required Actions

1. Urgently equip & activate the Jounieh NOC
2. Connect **all systems & solutions** including CCTV cameras to the NOC
3. Core cell to assign a 24/7 shifts attending the NOC
4. Demand from our cybersecurity partner a 24/7 monitoring
5. Safety & Security unit to enforce around the clock physical security of the critical sites
6. Request the Lebanese army to always attend to the critical sites

11. Situational assessment

Command cell at Ogero telecom has the duty of conducting ongoing risk assessment to understand the geopolitical situation and its potential impact on the operation. It can help OT management to take informed decisions regarding resources allocation & risks mitigation.

Required Actions

1. OT to be part of the national emergency unit
2. Report to Core & support cells the dynamics of the crisis
3. Develop agile field teams' extraction plans, staff evacuation & redeployment on safer grounds

12. Collaboration with MIC 1 & 2

Lebanese operators shall be invited to collaborate in times of crisis by sharing resources, information & maintaining essential communication services.

Required Actions

1. Share when possible physical & logical resources to maintain connectivity for the prioritized public services
2. OT to avail fiber connectivity for MIC's node sites
3. Allow national roaming among the 3 operators
4. Avail MICs NOCs monitoring premises & equipment to OT when needed
5. Avail CC premises & equipment to OT teams if & when needed

13. Compliance & regulations transgression

In case of emergencies, OT shall be concerned with service availability & sustainability. It goes without saying, time and swift actions shall become the operational norms. Consequently, the transgression of applicable laws & regulations is highly probable.

Required Actions

1. OT board resolution declaring state of emergency & transferring its powers to the CDG & his executive team
2. Issue a board resolution exempting OT from adhering to the Public Procurement law in accordance with PPL section “gre a gre”, para #2
3. Expenditures **during the eruption and continuation of the conflict**, are to be **considered “receivable”** by MoT & MoF provided spending is substantiated.
4. MoT to authorize OT to use the needed frequencies for wireless connectivity & fiber deployment & utilization during the possible conflict. It is understood related paperwork shall be done “ex post”

14. Humanitarian aid & support

Being part of national security, Ogero Telecom has the moral & professional obligation to extend support for humanitarian efforts, including facilitating communications for relief organizations & coordinating with government agencies for emergency response efforts.

Required Actions

1. **Avail call center activities** to civil defense, fire brigades & red cross
2. **Dedicate a public HOTLINE** for conflict repercussions & casualties
3. **Act as coordinator** between field emergency response teams & hospitals &/or national armed forces.
